

LAINGSBURG CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
August 1, 2016

Mayor Culpepper called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers.

Councilman Ducastel led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public comment was conducted.

- 95-16. Moved by L.C. Sparkes seconded by L.L. Sparkes to approve the minutes of July 11, 2016, with one correction. Motion carried.
- 96-16. Moved by Fredline, seconded by Ducastel to approve the Treasurer's Report, subject to audit. Motion carried.
- 97-16. Moved by Fredline, seconded by L.L. Sparkes to re-appoint Gail Geasler to the DDA for a four-year term. Roll call vote - Yeas: Ducastel, Fredline, L. C. Sparkes, L. L. Sparkes and Culpepper. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- 98-16. Moved by Fredline, seconded by L.L. Sparkes to accept the LSW Emergency Services Authority 2017-18 Budget, as presented. Motion carried.
- 99-16. Moved by L.C. Sparkes, seconded by Fredline to pay the bills in the amount of \$122,869.09 General Fund checks #38782– 38829. Also electronic payments of EFPTS \$5,567.78 - Federal withholding, Social Security and Medicare, also MERS - \$1,249.50 for July. Motion carried.
- 101-16. Moved by Fredline, seconded by L.C. Sparkes to authorize the Police Chief to follow *Procedure for handling a Public Nuisance*, set forth under the City Charter – Article III to deal with an abandoned mobile home that is in disrepair on parcel #022-60-002-000. Roll call vote - Yeas: Ducastel, Fredline, L. C. Sparkes, L. L. Sparkes and Micheal Culpepper. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- 100-16. Moved by L.L. Sparkes, seconded by L.C. Sparkes to approve an energy update for City Hall, Parks and Library as recommended by Total Source Energy; with our DPW crew doing installation. The amount of the improvements to cost approximately \$3,984. Roll call vote - Yeas: Ducastel, Fredline, L. C. Sparkes, L. L. Sparkes and Micheal Culpepper. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- 101-16. Moved by L.C. Sparkes, seconded by Ducastel to adjourn. The motion was unanimous and the meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
